SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PART ONE

The Standing Regulations for this event are Appendix 5, Schedule C of the current MSNZ manual.

1. JURISDICTION AND EVENT:

The event comprises a 2.4 km Hillclimb on good sealed public roads promoted by Waimate 50 Motorsport Incorporated.

The event will be held under these supplementary regulations and the current National Sporting Code of Motorsport NZ and it's relevant Appendices and Schedules, particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C.

Motorsport NZ permit number is 9976

3. ENTRY FEE:

Entry Fee \$70.00 Per Driver, inclusive of GST and MSNZ levies.

Late Entry Fee \$95.00 Per Driver, inclusive of GST and MSNZ levies.

4. ENTRIES:

The entries open with the publication of these regulations and will be accepted up to 5pm on Friday 10th April 2013. A maximum of 50 entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Late entries may be accepted at the organiser's discretion until drivers briefing commences, Sunday, 19th May 2013. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code. Waimate 50 Motorsport Inc. reserves the right to cancel the event or any part thereof should less than 15 entries be received.

Entries from two drivers sharing the same car will be accepted but each must lodge a separate individual entry and note who they are sharing with on the entry form.

Full entry fee must accompany all entries – unpaid entries will not be accepted.

5. COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY:

Drivers must hold a minimum of a MSNZ M Grade Competition Licence and current MSNZ Affiliated Club membership. Anyone requiring a Temporary M Grade Competition Licence should contact a MSNZ Licence Issuing Steward and make arrangements to acquire this before the event.

All competitors, including passengers, shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A of the current MSNZ Manual.

Passengers may be carried in vehicles complying with Appendix 5, Schedule C, Part 1, 6.2 of the current MSNZ Manual and must sign the passenger indemnity form at the start line before each run.

The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed "Clubsport Event Under Age Indemnity and Consent Form" (MSNZ form CS010) or a MSNZ competition licence stamped "Authorised Minor". Form CS010 can be downloaded from the MSNZ web site or will be available at the event.

6. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY:

Vehicles will comply with Appendix 2, Schedule A of the current MSNZ Manual except for Pre 1978 Schedule K, T&C or CR vehicles that are in compliance with Appendix Six Schedule AA.

MSNZ approved roll protection and full harness restraints are highly recommended.

Tyres as per Schedule A. (no slicks).

Competitors should be familiar with and adhere to the MSNZ Code of Practice – Fuel, which is available on the MSNZ website (www.motorsport.org.nz).

7. CLASSES

0 to 1300cc 2WD

1301cc to 1600cc 2WD

Unlimited 2WD

Unlimited 4WD

If there are fewer than four (4) entries in any one class, the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes.

8. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING:

Documentation and audit scrutineering (if required) will be at the venue Sunday 19th May from 8.00am to 9.30am.

Remote scrutineering may be arranged in your local area prior to the event if entry numbers warrant it. If so, the log book must be presented at documentation.

9. RUNNING OF THE EVENT:

Drivers Briefing and Roll Call will be held at the start line at 9.30am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory and failure to attend may result in a penalty. An Indian File run will commence as soon as drivers briefing is completed.

Time permitting, there will be up to 6 timed runs with the fastest time counting towards results. In the event of 6 timed runs not being completed, results will be calculated on completed runs only.

Timing will be by rally timing.

10. OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD:

The Official Notice Board will be at Event Control.

11. EVENT CONTROL:

Event Control will be located at the start line.

Interim results (if available) and any other essential information will be displayed at Event Control. It is the competitor's responsibility to be acquainted with this information.

The Clerk of the Course can be contacted through Event Control.

12. RESULTS:

Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after competition finishes.

13. DIRECTIONS TO TARA HILLS ROAD

To access the venue from Waimate, take the Hakataramea Highway to Waihao Downs, approximately 14 km, and turn right onto Serpentine Valley Road. The start area is approximately 12 km from the Hakataramea Highway.

To access from the south, turn left at Glenavy onto Glenavy Tawai Road, veer right onto Ikawai Middle Road, turn right onto Hakataramea Highway, then turn left onto Serpentine Valley Road. The start area is approximately 12 km from the Hakataramea Highway.

14. FOOD
