**Under 14 years on day of competition \$5**

**Family Ticket**

**Not more than 2 Adults and 4 children under 14**  
**Member \$30; Non Member \$40**

The \$5 for under 14 years enters the child in the Youth Under 14 Prize Pool. If they wish to enter the Adult Prize pool the entry fee is \$15. (Non Members can be launched and retrieved for free once entry fee is paid)

**You need to be back in the Weigh-in line at the BBBC clubrooms by 3.30pm.**

**RULES**

- Tickets may be purchased on Sundays prior to the competition day between 3 pm to 6 pm. and from 5:45 to 9:30 am on the competition day.
- **You must communicate to the Event Co-ordinator your time and place of launching prior to launching and your return to shore.**
  - No lines to be in the water before 6 am..
- Area of Fishing is restricted to those areas on Chart 532, Approaches to Auckland. If the Area of Fishing is further restricted to the Waitemata Harbour, launching and retrieval must be from within that area.
  - Weigh in 3.30—4.30 pm at BBBC Club Rooms irrespective of the Area of Fishing.
- If you are not in the line by the start of weigh-in your fish will not be weighed in. (*The Event Committee may waive this rule for incidences beyond your control i.e. a breakdown, however such requests must be notified to the Event Coordinator as soon as practicable after the incident occurs and no later than the start of weigh-in*)
  - **A Maximum of one Fish per person will be weighed in for each category**
  - Fishing competition prizes are for fish caught with a rod and reel or a hand line, from a boat or from the shore.
    - A maximum of two hooks allowed per line in the water. I.e. No set lines.
  - Trophies will be awarded to BBBC members only. Prizes are open to all registered and paid up competitors.
    - Fish weighed in must adhere to the Ministry of Fisheries regulations.
      - All decisions of the Event Committee shall be final.

**Postponement**

If the Met Service at <http://www.metservice.co.nz/default/index.php?alias=aucklandinshore>, either on or about 1915 Hrs on Saturday 11th February or no later than 0530 Hrs on 12 February, forecasts wind speeds 15 kts or higher in the Hauraki Gulf, the Event Committee may decide to restrict the Fishing Area to the Waitemata Harbour West of North Head, if favourable conditions are forecast in that area. Otherwise the competition will be postponed. If postponed, the committee will decide and advise an alternate day however, tickets may then be refunded on request. Restricted areas or Postponements will notified by notice on the Marine Centre Door, the [www.BBBC.co.nz](http://www.BBBC.co.nz) web site and by email to those who have notified email addresses.
