

# Victoria Esplanade Permanent Orienteering Course

A Permanent Orienteering Course consisting of 24 checkpoints is set out in the Esplanade and adjacent Manawaroa and Ongley Parks. The notice board outside the Conservatory across the road from Café Esplanade marks the Start and the Finish place for all courses.

Orienteering involves using a map to find your way cross-country around a set course. On each course the checkpoints called controls are marked on the map by purple circles. Each circle indicates a feature where a control marker is placed. There is an example of a control marker attached to the right hand post holding up the notice board.

The map gives a detailed representation of the terrain. The challenge is to navigate a good route between controls.

Maps are available for \$2 from the Café Esplanade and from the Visitor Information Centre in the Square. Instructions are on the back of the map.
