

## **Denis Delaney and Judith Dormer – as at 23 August 2003**

abt 1790 - 1860 Clonbrock County Laois

In 2003 we know that Denis was a carrier and at 19 November 1817 they resided in Clonbrock in the R. Catholic Parish of Doonane artly in the civil parishes of Rathaspick and Killabban--PLU of Carlow Barony of Slievemargy and Province of Leinster. Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin. County of Laois formerly Queens also known as Leix. (Laois is bounded by Kilkenny to Sth Kildare to East Tipperary to west and Offaly to Nth.) Clonbrock is on Hiway N78 ref 59/78 and close to Carlow.

Nearby villages are Mayo-Aughreena-Newtown-Castlecomer - Crettyard - there is no village in Doonane. On Elizabeth Delaney's birth entry (dau of Martin 1873) the Registry is recorded as Bollickmoyler (Supt. Registrar Carlow) - St.Abbans Church is in Doonane and the Church of Blessed Mary in Mayo.

It seems there were 7 sons but so far we only have marriage and offspring details for John Dormer, Martin and wife Fanny Brennan - between 1863 and 1875 at locations of Clonbrock and Doonane although this could be just a notation.

From register we know there was a Mary Delaney and Anne Delaney who were sponsors for baptism of William, Michael and Luke.

From Griffiths Valuation 1848-1864 we know Judith Delaney nee Dormer, Catherine 61a and Mary Dormer 61c occupied residences in Clonbrock in 1848 - 1864 as did Michael Delaney 71a Mary and John Brennan 61c and 78c - some lived in places owned by John Edge.

Judith Delaney 70a and b had land and House and but also a tenant.

- 1) Denis Delaney - entry yet to be found b.abt 1797 married abt 1817.
- 2) Judith Dormer - ditto those baptized at Doonane
- 3) Matthew Delaney 9/11/1817 no record of marriage at Doonane –1813 - 1899 nor death 1883 - 1929 irregularly kept.
- 4) John Dormer Delaney 14/3/1820 left Ireland abt 1838 in 27<sup>th</sup> Reg of Foot - See separate Chapter John Dormer and re Military History
- 5) William Delaney 19/1/1876 a marriage to Catherine Condron of Mayo but he would be 54 YO at that time?
- 6) Martin Delaney 15/8/1824 note of marriage to Mary Brennan 4/5/1844 - see also marriage to Fanny Brennan below.
- 7) Denis Delaney 2nd 27/9/1831
- 8) Michael b.14/9/1834 married Ellen Brien 25/2/1854 Witness Pat hale and Marg.Brennan
- 9) Luke B. 10/10/1836 married Anne Condron 24/1/1857 Witness Dan Kilroy / Marg Foley.
- 10) Martin married Fanny (Frances ) Brennan 29/9/1861 Witness Ed Mulhall / Marg Williams. Their children Alicia 9/6/1863, Mary 11/6/1865, James

12/11/1867, John 3rd Delaney 9/10/1870, Eliza (Elizabeth) 20/3/1873 have

All the above except Denis 1 and Judith recorded in Doonane register.

There appears to be no Parish death entries between 1883—1929.

Have not fully viewed 1901 or 1911 census as yet.
